Falling off during activity - Users	Adult / Parent / Guardian supervision at all times	1	5	5	Ensure all users comply with the manufacture's guidance supplied on each ride on toy
Over enthusiastic participants - Users	Responsible Supervision At all times.	3	3	9	Responsible person supervising at all times. Riding / bashing / or deliberately crashing into others or area around you is not permitted.
Danger of unnecessary injury - Users	Responsible Supervision At all times.	5	2	10	Ensure that no one with a history of back / neck problems, heart conditions, anyone who is feeling unwell, is suffering the effects of alcohol or drugs use do NOT use any equipment at any time.
Overcrowding of Equipment - Users	Responsible Supervision At all times.	5	2	10	Ensure only one user per ride on toy is allowed. Do not overcrowd the ride on toys in one area. Limit the age / height of users to specified agreements in the terms of hire or on the ride on toy itself.
Larger participants colliding with smaller participants – Users	Responsible person supervising at all times ensuring participants are placed in weight / height categories or in similar size categories for safe use.	5	2	10	Ensure users follow the manufactures guidance on the front of the ride on toys
Adverse weather conditions – Users/Equipment	Indoor use only	N/A	N/A	N/A	These toys are only suitable for indoor use and must not be used outdoors, this damages the wheels, bearings and steering devices.
Injury through lack of supervision - Users	Responsible Supervision At all times.	5	2	10	Supervisor must be present with the ride on toys at all times, in the event that the supervisor is not in view, do not use the ride on toys under any circumstances
Choking - Users	No food, drinks, chewing gum, balloons, silly string or alike to be allowed on or near the ride on toys.	5	2	10	Ensure users don't put any part of the ride on toy in their mouths, this also is for HYGIENE REASONS
Injury through 3rd party items and 3rd part bodies / spectators - Users	All shoes, glasses, jewellery, badges MUST be removed before using the ride on toys.	3	3	9	Always ensure that the area surrounding the activity is not overcrowded and free from objects or hazards.
Injury through defected ride on toy - Users	Visual inspections during set up and check for defects	3	1	3	Supervisor to remove any defected or broken items / equipment from use
Skidding on equipment – Users/Public	Responsible Supervision At all times.	3	2	6	Skidding on equipment is not allowed. It should be used in a controlled fashion only anyone using in such a way should be removed
Participants falling off of ride on toy due to overloading – Users	Supervisions at all time by a responsible Adult	3	3	9	Ensure that the hirer is made aware of the intended use of the equipment and inform them to monitor pro-actively. Only Single riders permitted.
